Our Mission

To help improve the quality of life and well-being of aging Coloradans.

We work with other groups of advocates with similar interests; we listen to others with different ideas; we converse with our elected and appointed officials about issues of importance to our mission - including facts, personal stories. It's a process.

There are many steps involved in effective advocacy and lobbying. As a CSL member volunteer, you may select one or more of them as their way to be involved. **You could:**

- Participate in person or by phone in our weekly Legislative Committee meetings to discuss ideas, policies, and legislation.
- Research policy issues for CSL to proactively promote, and providing that research to those who make regular appearances at the Capitol as our representative advocates (THIS COULD BE YOU).
- Dig into legislation proposed by our state senators and representatives - helping us understand potential impacts.
- Become an active advocate/citizen lobbyist for CSL (or yourself) at the Capitol.

It's much easier than you may think.

Prepare **YOURSELF** to focus on:

- Problem being solved with the piece of legislation being discussed
- Bring personal perspective (your own is best, but that of another is good too)
- Make an effort to understand both sides of the
- issue and the key points of each

Benefits of Membership:

- **You will have access to the current CSL Legislative Bill Position report** – a key piece of information each legislative session.
- **You will have a vote on legislative proposals that CSL is considering as impacting seniors.** (This means you can participate by phone or in person in CSL's weekly legislative meetings as all participants discuss senior-related legislation that is proposed or is moving through the General Assembly and help decide CSL's position on each item.)
- **Members may choose to represent CSL's position at committee hearings** in the legislature and with individual legislators.
- **Monthly Newsletter** - Members may submit an opinion piece for the newsletter. We will publish one piece each month. (limit 400 words)
- **You may become a candidate for the CSL Board of Directors**
- **Satisfaction of contributing to the ever-growing voice of Colorado's older adult community while being a significant supporter of CSL programs and events.**

- Help us with events like our annual Senior Day at the Capitol
- Experience how government really works
- Work together with other members advocating for Colorado's older adults
